BACKGROUND OF THE PROJECT

- The BSR value is only 16% of total EU GDP.
- The BSR has insufficient use of it's innovation potential.
- In the BSR we have an innovation system that primarily limits the scope of the innovation concept to men, usually men of the majority population.
- There is a need to promote new approaches to innovation support, i.e promote models that can bolster the innovation of innovatively marginalized groups and by extension the innovation capacity of SMEs.
