Statistics show...

- 1,1 million Swedes is still not using the internet.
- The most common reason (63 %) for not using the Internet is lack of interest and 23 % of the non-users think technology is too complicated.
- The biggest difference between women and men's digital inclusion is among people with low incomes.
- The highest proportion of people who have never used the internet, are in the age group 75-85 years, and in that group women are overrepresented.
- In Skåne, among engineers and technicians, 80 % are men.
